



Summer Camp Opportunity for DC Youth (Ages 7–13)

This program is designed to provide a safe, engaging, and enriching summer experience for youth while supporting working families and expanding access to high-quality opportunities across Washington, DC.

Georgia Avenue Family Support Collaborative (GAFSC) is a trusted community-based organization dedicated to supporting children, youth, and families to become healthy, empowered, and connected. Through its network of services, GAFSC provides family support, case management, and wraparound resources that strengthen communities across the District.

United to Rise (U2R), formerly known as Youth Organizations United to Rise and YOUR Community Center, has been serving youth and families in Washington, DC since 1997. With nearly 30 years of experience operating summer camps and youth development programs, U2R has a strong track record of delivering high-quality programming that supports academic growth, leadership development, and student success. Program Overview

The STREAMING Summer Camp is a free, full-day summer program for youth ages 7–13, focused on academic enrichment, hands-on learning, physical activity, and social-emotional development. STREAMING stands for: Science, Technology, Reading, Engineering, Arts, Mathematics, Individuality (Social-Emotional Learning), Nutrition, and Geography (Cultural Awareness).

Participants will engage in:

- Daily academic enrichment in reading and math
- Hands-on STEM and technology activities
- Social-emotional learning and leadership development
- Arts, creative expression, and cultural exploration
- Health, nutrition, and fitness activities
- Field trips and experiential learning opportunities

Eligibility & Cost

This program is FREE for families through a scholarship-based model.

Priority will be given to families who are economically disadvantaged, as demonstrated by eligibility for:

- TANF (Temporary Assistance for Needy Families)
- SNAP (Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program)
- Free- and Reduced-Price School Meals

Application & Enrollment Process

- Application Deadline: June 13, 2026
- Orientation Period: Week of June 1-13, 2026
- Each family will be required to attend a 2-hour application interview session

Due to high demand and limited space, participants will be selected through a lottery system after June 13. Families selected through the lottery will be notified and officially enrolled in the program.
